## Kilimanjaro Climb: Conquer the Marangu Route in 5 Days

5 days. 1.800€ per person

**Marangu Route: The Most Accessible Way to Conquer Kilimanjaro**

The Marangu route, known as the “Coca-Cola route”, is the most classic and accessible option to reach the majestic peak of Kilimanjaro. As the oldest and most established route, it offers a gradual ascent making it an excellent choice for those looking for a less demanding but equally exciting challenge.

One of its great advantages is the comfort of its shelters, which eliminates the need for tents, making your experience more comfortable and practical. Although the minimum number of days to complete this adventure is five, at Asilion Travels we recommend including an additional day to acclimatize and maximize your chances of success in reaching the summit.

Along the way, you will cross landscapes that seem taken from different worlds: tropical jungles full of life, mystical breezes, alpine deserts and, finally, the imposing glaciers that guard the top of the mount. All of this culminates at Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa, where the effort of each step is rewarded with views that will take your breath away.

### ■ ITINERARY

#### **Day 0: Arrival in Tanzania**

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you will be transferred to your hotel in Moshi or Arusha. In the afternoon, you will meet your guide for a pre-trekking talk, where you will also review the necessary equipment. If you are missing something, don't worry, you can rent it on site.

#### **Day 1: Hotel to Marangu Gate and Mandara Hut**

After breakfast, we will head to the entrance of Kilimanjaro National Park for registration. The walk begins through a dense tropical jungle, home of primates and lush vegetation, until reaching the Mandara refuge. If you're feeling energetic, you can visit Maundi Crater and enjoy the views of Kenya.

- Elevation: 1860 m to 2700 m
- Distance: 8 km (3-4 hours)
- Habitat: Montane forest
- Meals: Lunch and dinner





### Day 3: Horombo Refuge to Kibo Refuge

This day involves a longer route, leaving behind us the last source of water. You will walk through the "saddle," a plateau that connects the summits of Mawenzi and Kibo, until you reach the Kibo hut, where you will rest before the big night climb.

- Elevation: 3700 m to 4700 m
- Distance: 9 km (5-6 hours)
- Habitat: Alpine desert
- Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner

### Day 4: Kibo Refuge – Peak – Horombo Refuge

The final ascent begins around midnight. With constant effort, you will first reach Gillman's Point at dawn and then Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa. After enjoying the views, you will return to the Kibo hut to rest and then continue to the Horombo hut.

- Elevation: 4700 m to 5895 m (summit) and descent to 3700 m
- Distance: 6 km up / 15 km down (6-8 hours up and 4-6 hours down)
- Habitat: Alpine desert
- Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner

### Day 5: Horombo Shelter to Marangu Gate

The final day is a downhill walk through heathland and rainforest, returning to the park entrance. From there, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Moshi to enjoy a well-deserved hot shower and celebrate your achievement.

- Elevation: 3700 m to 1700 m
- Distance: 20 km (4-5 hours)
- Habitat: Forest
- Meals: Breakfast





## Ascent of Kilimanjaro via the Machame route

For those who have only six days to conquer Kilimanjaro, the Machame route is the ideal option thanks to its excellent acclimatization profile. Unlike other routes of the same duration, it allows you to reach higher altitudes from the beginning, favoring a faster adaptation of the body to the altitude.

The Machame route combines spectacular views and a variety of landscapes, from lush rainforests to alpine deserts and impressive glaciers. Of course, its demanding slope requires good physical fitness and determination to face the challenges that await you.

## Kilimanjaro Climb Lemosho Route

The Lemosho route is the ideal option for those looking for a peaceful experience, surrounded by impressive landscapes and with a high success rate when reaching the summit of Kilimanjaro. This itinerary begins on the western side of the mountain, with a journey from Moshi to the Londorossi Gate, where the trek officially begins. For the first two days, you will travel through a lush rainforest until you reach the Shira Plateau.

Although it can be completed in 7 days, at Asilion Travels we recommend extending it to 8 days to improve acclimatization and increase the chances of success in the climb. The route connects with the Machame route at Shira 2 camp and continues through the southern circuit, ensuring less traffic and views less explored by other trekkers. The descent is made through the Mweka Gate, completing an epic adventure that will take you through landscapes that seem taken from another world.

Optional to take an acclimatization walk at 4200 m before returning to the camp.

#### **Day 5: From Karanga Camp to Barafu Camp**

Ascent towards the Barafu camp (4640 m), crossing desolate stairs without vegetation. The climb is hard and challenging due to the altitude. Upon arrival, we rest, have an early dinner and prepare for the climb to the summit, which will begin around midnight.

- Elevation: 4050m - 4700m
- Distance: 3 km (3 hours)
- Includes meals.

#### **Day 6: Uhuru Peak and descent to Millennium Camp**

We started at midnight ascending a steep slope towards the glaciers at the summit. After about 4-5 hours, we arrived at Stella Point (5739m) just at sunrise, surrounded by stunning ice cliffs and views of Mawenzi Peak. Another hour takes us to the highest point in Africa, Uhuru Peak (5895 m). Afterwards, we descend to Stella Point and continue to Barafu Camp for breakfast, before continuing to Millennium Camp to rest.

- Elevation: 4700 m - 5895 m - 3790 m
- Distance: 13.4 km (12-15 hours)
- Includes meals.

#### **Day 7: From Mweka Camp to Mweka Gate**

A leisurely walk takes us through the rainforest to the Mweka gate, where we complete the park formalities and receive our certificates. Afterwards, return to the hotel in Moshi.

- Elevation: 3090 m - 1680 m
- Distance: 12.1 km (6 hours)
- Includes breakfast and lunch.

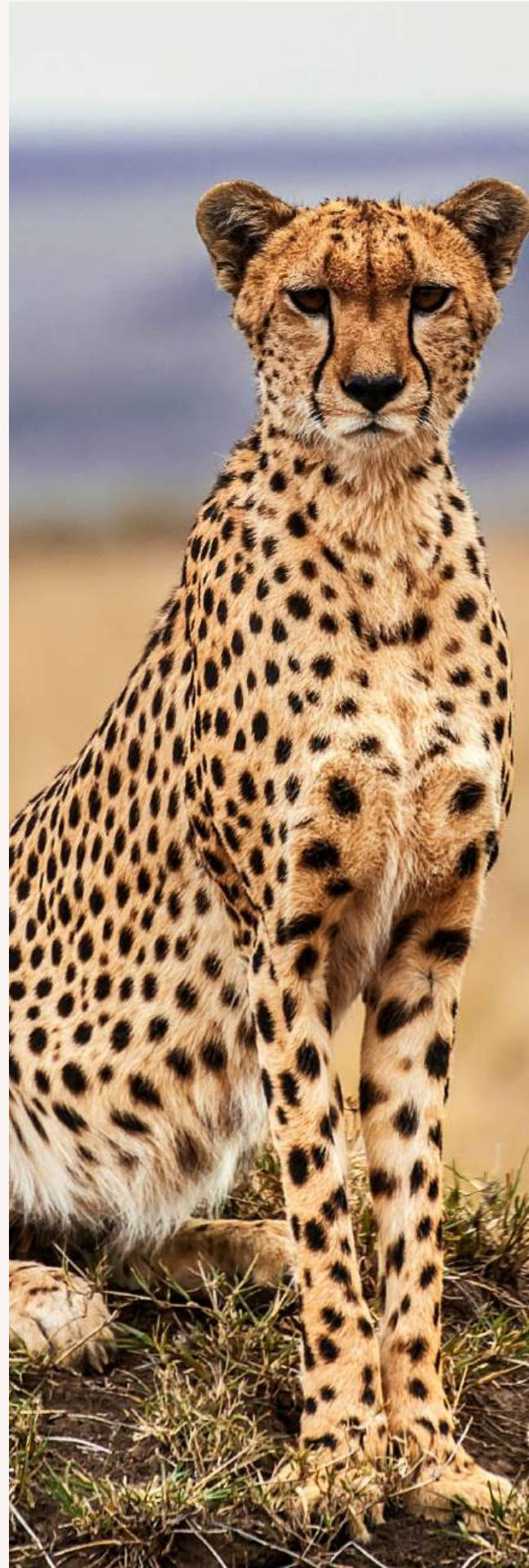
